I. General Provisions

The Controller has not appointed a Data Protection Officer.

II. Sources and Categories of Processed Personal Data

The Controller processes the personal data that you have provided via the contact form on the website:

The Controller processes your identification and contact details solely for the purposes outlined in Article III.

III. Legal Basis and Purpose of Personal Data Processing

The legal basis for processing personal data is your consent for processing your data for the purpose of responding to your inquiry submitted via the contact form, pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, point (a) of the GDPR.

The purpose of processing personal data is to handle your inquiry submitted via the contact form and to fulfill related rights and obligations.

The Controller does not engage in automated individual decision-making within the meaning of Article 22 of the GDPR.

IV. Retention Period for Personal Data

The Controller will store your personal data for the period necessary to respond to your inquiry and handle related claims (up to 2 years from the resolution of the inquiry).

Once the retention period has expired, the Controller will delete your personal data.

V. Recipients of Personal Data (Controller's Subcontractors)

Recipients of personal data include: - Persons involved in handling your inquiry.

The Controller does not intend to transfer personal data to a third country (outside the EU) or to an international organization.

VI. Your Rights

Under the conditions set forth in the GDPR, you have:

- The right to access your personal data under Article 15 of the GDPR.
- The right to rectify your personal data under Article 16 of the GDPR, or to restrict processing under Article 18 of the GDPR.
- The right to erasure of personal data under Article 17 of the GDPR.
- The right to object to processing under Article 21 of the GDPR.
- The right to data portability under Article 20 of the GDPR.
- The right to withdraw consent for processing in writing or electronically to the address or email of the Controller as specified in Article I of these conditions.
- The right to file a complaint with the Office for Personal Data Protection if you believe that your right to data protection has been violated.

VII. Conditions for Securing Personal Data

The Controller declares that it has taken all appropriate technical and organizational measures to secure personal data.

The Controller has implemented technical measures to secure data storage and physical storage of personal data, including password protection and antivirus protection.

The Controller declares that access to personal data is granted only to authorized persons.

VIII. Final Provisions
